## ACTS

According to the Airlangga University Credit Transfer System (ACTS), one Indonesian credit of learning activity consists of:

- One hour (50 minutes) of structured and scheduled meeting (teaching) per week per semester;
- 2. One hour (50 minutes) of structured but unscheduled activity (assignments etc.) per week per semester;
- 3. One hour (50 minutes) of unstructured and unscheduled activity (independent activity) per week per semester.

#### **KONVERSI SKS KE ECTS**

1 SKS kuliah (Dikti) = 35 jam studi per semester (14 x pertemuan @ 150 menit)
1 sks praktikum = 40 jam studi per semester (14x pertemuan @170 menit)

1 year of studies, usually applies to graduate certificates - 60 ECTS-credits
 3-year Bachelor's programme - 180 ECTS-credits
 2-year Master's programme - 120 ECTS-credits

#### ECTS credits may include different amounts of study hours

This means that usually a module or course with 10 ECTS credits has approximately twice the workload of a course with 5 ECTS. But why just in theory? Depending on the country, one ECTS credit point can equal on average between 25 and 30 actual study hours. Examples include: •Austria, Italy, and Spain - 1 ECTS = 25 study hours •Finland - 1 ECTS = 27 study hours •The Netherlands, Portugal - 1 ECTS = 28 study hours •Germany, Belgium, Romania, and Hungary - 1 ECTS = 30 study hours
